# Bulletin column January 12, 2020 "From the Pastor" Getting to know Fr. Joseph Broudou

I am Fr. Joseph Broudou (pronounced Brew-dew). My legal name at birth was Joseph Herve Gilles Bergera Broudou. Since I became an American Citizen in 2006, I am now legally Joseph Gilles Broudou. When I grew up, I went by the name Gilles. I started to go by Joseph since 1994 at the request of then-Omaha priest Fr. Joseph Hanafeldt, who is now the Bishop of the diocese of Grand Island, Nebraska. In the English world I am Fr. Joseph, in the French world I am Pere Gilles and in the Spanish world I am Padre Jose.

I am originally from the country of Mauritius. For geography lesson Mauritius is situated roughly 20 degrees south of the Equator and 60 degrees east of Greenwich, in simple English 500 miles off the East coast of Madagascar in the Indian Ocean. My family have been Catholics for generations. I am of French, African, Indian, and Asian origin. I speak four languages – French, English, Creole and Spanish.

I was born on August 9<sup>th</sup> 1963. I am the third of six. I have a brother in Canada, a sister in Australia, a sister in Reunion Island, and two sisters in Mauritius. Most of my relatives live in Australia.

I lived in Australia from 1988 to 1989. I moved to Singapore (Jan 1989 – Feb 1992) to join the Society of the Sons of the Father (Patrists) and made profession in December of 1992 in Oakdale NE. I then discerned to become a priest for the Archdiocese of Omaha.

I did my philosophical studies at the St. Francis Major Seminary in Singapore (Jan 1989 - Dec 1991). I did my theological studies at the Pontifical College Josephinum, Columbus Ohio (Sept 1992

- June 1996) and graduated with an M. Div. I have a MA in Christian Spirituality from Creighton University (1997-2000). I did the IPF formation for priests (2004-2007). I have also done the formation Good Leaders/Good Shepherds (2013-2014). I am still a student of Spanish. We learn from the womb to the tomb.

I was ordained for the Archdiocese of Omaha on June 1<sup>st</sup> 1996. My assignments are as thus, with several overlapping:

I left the Archdiocese in June of 2008 to join the Community of the Beatitudes in Denver Colorado. I returned to the Archdiocese as the Community of the Beatitudes was asked by Rome to review its statutes due to internal problems. Since then the Beatitudes are doing fine.

In 2014 I joined the Order of St. Augustine (OSA). I lived one year in Chicago for my pre-novitiate where I started to learn Spanish. I did my novitiate in Racine Wisconsin in 2015 and made profession in 2016. From July of 2016 to June of 2019 I was the Pastor of Our Mother of Good Counsel in Homer Glen IL and I lived with the teaching community in New Lenox IL. I discerned to depart the Augustinians last year to return to the Archdiocese of Omaha.

Since I came back, I have been in Schuyler to learn Spanish, and now I am here at St. Michael in South Sioux City for the next three months replacing Fr. Mike Keating, who is doing his immersion in the Spanish language in Guatemala. I count on your prayers and help as I continue to learn the Spanish language. After here, God knows my next assignment. I have lived in nearly 30 addresses since my birth. I am like a gypsy or a "Roaming Catholic" or a missionary.

I have learned a lot about the faith while teaching it especially to the children in Catholic schools and Religious Ed (CCD). I feel that the New Evangelization to which Pope St. John Paul II first called us will flourish when there would be a reevangelization of the Catholics.

I look forward to my assignment here. I will do my best and let God do the rest.

May the love of God the Father, the peace of Jesus and the joy of the Holy Spirit abide with you and your loved ones.

#### PARISH ANNOUNCEMENTS
