

Beginning Monday, August 31st, all traditional and distance scholars will begin following the same schedule to streamline their instruction. The benefit to our scholars who originally chose distance learning is that they will have a more structured day with their advisors and more direct instruction. The plan is as follows:

<p>Schedule</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Advisors will have 4 face-to-face meetings per day, at 8:30 AM, 10:00 AM, 11:30 AM, 2:00 PM ● Not every meeting applies to every scholar in the class ● These include special services, such as EIP, Gifted, Special Education, and EL, as well as Bridges classes, World Languages and interventions ● These rotate with a Monday/Wednesday plan and a Tuesday/Thursday plan ● This allows for instruction time and work time ● There is time between meetings to allow you to provide transitions in your scholar's day, including breaks, snacks and meals, etc. ● We realize not all scholars will be able to attend every meeting at its scheduled time, and we do not suggest that you plan for them to be online for the whole day ● Lessons will be recorded for scholars who cannot attend at the scheduled time
<p>Attendance</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Attendance checks will be completed daily through Google Classroom
<p>Lessons</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Each face-to-face meeting will be provided for about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 45 minutes for middle and high school, ○ 30 minutes for 3rd - 5th grade, and ○ 10-20 minutes for K - 2nd grade, based on the age group ● Will be recorded for scholars who cannot attend lessons at the scheduled online meeting time ● May include recordings of advisor instruction to be accessed prior to the face-to-face meeting, which is when the advisor will be working with the scholars through guided completion of work ● Work will be assigned to be completed outside the face-to-face meetings
<p>Work Due</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● We will continue to follow our Late Work Guidelines for each grade level ● Parents should communicate with advisors in advance if there is an extenuating circumstance requiring an additional grace period
<p>Parent Communication</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● We will continue to push out school-wide communication through Google Classroom, on our website, and via our Facebook page, which is also where our plan will be published ● You will be invited by advisors to sign up for Guardian Summaries from Google Classrooms in order to receive regular communication regarding assignments and performance ● We need you to communicate your needs to your advisors as soon as possible so they can help you and your scholar ● Our goal is to communicate a plan for the second nine weeks by the beginning of October <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ That plan will also be published
<p>Meals</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Scholars must sign up for weekly meal pickups ● Weekly sign-up for meals is provided through Google Classrooms, our school website and Facebook page ● Weekly meal pick-up includes a week's worth of breakfast and lunch for scholars who sign up ● Pick-up is scheduled each Friday, 11:00 AM- 1:30 PM, outside the red hall. Signs will be posted.
