The Finance Committee reviewed the variable accounts report. They also locked in oil and diesel prices at \$2.07, which is consistent with the prior year. Lastly, they reviewed pending vendor invoices and budget reports.

A meeting of the Wolcott Public Schools' Facilities Committee was held on Monday, November 26, 2018, at Tyrrell Middle School's Library. In attendance were: Thomas Buzzelli, Chair of the Facilities Committee; Lori Delbuono Bartlett, Chairman of the Board; Christopher Charette, and Roberta Leonard. Also in attendance: Dr. Anthony Gasper, Superintendent of Schools; Todd Bendtsen, Business Manager; and Wayne Natzel Facilities Director.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Mr. Buzzelli.


The committee heard from Dr. Gasper, who discussed school enrollment history and projections from school years 2013-14 through 2020-21. There was discussion of reconfiguring grade levels at Wakelee, Alcott, and Tyrrell Schools. This was a review of additional methods for consolidation of schools.

Lastly, the committee reviewed and discussed Wolcott High School Locker Room improvements. They spoke of current issues regarding transgender students. Dr. Gasper, Mr. Drewry, and Mr. Natzel review modifying locker rooms for allowing privacy and the process for making privacy considerations. Preliminary monies are projected to cost at least \$10,000. Mr. Natzel will give the superintendent financial figures to present to the finance committee.
