

AP Computer Science Principles

AP Computer Science Principles is built around the fundamentals of computing including problem solving, working with data, understanding the Internet, cyber security, and programming. This course encourages a broader participation in the study of computer science and other STEM fields. The AP assessment consists of two performance tasks students complete during the school year and a multiple-choice written exam in the spring. This course has very little homework outside of regular review of coursework. Students in this class should be strong academically and can be a sophomore, junior, or senior.
