

Good evening parents of the Randolph County School System,

This is Stephen Gainey. I am calling to make you aware of the following items:

- 1) The school system has created a survey in an effort to obtain feedback from students, parents, and staff members regarding the remote learning plan implemented during the past two months. Through the use of this survey, the school system wants to gather feedback in relation to the following questions:
 - a) What worked well with our remote learning plan during the past two months?
 - b) What did not work well with our remote learning plan during the past two months?
 - c) What changes and improvements are needed going forward with regard to our remote learning plan?

The link to the survey will be posted on our school system's webpage, Facebook page, and Twitter account as well as each school's webpage tomorrow (May 21) at 10:00 a.m. In addition, the link to the survey will be emailed to all staff members tomorrow (May 21) at 10:00 a.m. I encourage all students, parents, and staff members to complete this survey. The survey will close at 8:00 p.m. on May 28. The feedback from this survey will be critical in our efforts to develop our school system's remote learning plan for use in the future as needed.

- 2) All schools will host an event on Thursday (May 21) from 7:30 a.m.-6:00 p.m. for students to come to school campuses to deliver their completed instructional packets distributed on March 19, April 7, and May 5. I encourage all students and parents to bring these instructional materials back to school campuses on this day. Staff members need these materials to finalize the academic records for students for the 2019-2020 school year.
- 3) All schools will host an event on June 4 from 7:30 a.m.-6:00 p.m. for students to come to school campuses to deliver any additional completed instructional packets as well as chromebooks, library books, textbooks, athletic team uniforms, and any other school property. In addition, one person per car will be allowed to enter the school to pick up personal items remaining in the building since March 13.
- 4) Our Board of Education approved the revised school calendar for the 2020-2021 school year at its meeting on May 18. This calendar has been posted on our school system's webpage, Facebook page, and Twitter account. Please note that, due to legislative action several weeks ago, the first student day of the 2020-2021 school year has been changed to August 17, not August 24 as originally planned.

In closing, I want to "thank" all parents for your continued support of our school system.
