Regular Board Meeting
March 16, 2021

The Board of Education of Independent School District #330 held its regular board meeting on Tuesday, March 16, 2021. John Volk called the meeting to order. In attendance were John Volk, Annie Rasche, Bob Egge, Katie Janssen, Nathan Hay and ex officio Paul Bang. Absent was Mark Fest. A quorum was declared with majority members in attendance.

Bang gave the Superintendent's Report. Enrollment is at 300. Will look at a review of the policies to be updated. Blue Heron Days has asked to use parking lot for parade lineup.

Board member reports: NCIC – No meeting. Facilities – working on ion purification. HLOCF – None. Negotiations – none.

A first reading of the non-discrimination policy additions was given for review.

Rasche moved, seconded by Egge to approve open enrollment student from Fulda. The motion carried unanimously.

Egge moved, seconded by Janssen to approve the fundraisers for the following: Frozen Cookie Dough, Frozen Cinnamon roll dough and Frozen Butterbraids. The motion carried unanimously.

Egge moved, seconded by Hay to accept the retirement of High School Math teacher, Sharon Carter at the end of the year. The motion carried unanimously.

Rasche moved, seconded by Egge to accept the retirement of elementary teacher, Connie Hesse at the end of the year. The motion carried unanimously.

Rasche moved, seconded by Janssen to declare as surplus the replaced elementary AED. The motion carried unanimously.

Egge moved, seconded by Janssen to approve planting of sterile crab apple trees along the Baseball Field. The motion carried unanimously.

Hay moved, seconded by Egge to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried unanimously.
