

Report Cards/Grading	Student report cards will be mailed out on Monday, April 27. If students do not receive their report card by Friday, May 1, please contact the school office at 731-986-8223. The office is open each weekday from 9am-1pm. In accordance with our State Board of Education Uniform Grading Policy and grading requirements for grades 9-12, student grades will reflect work completed from January 7-March 18, prior to our dismissal for COVID-19. An additional weighting has been applied to students' final grades in consideration for students not having the opportunity to increase their final grade the fourth nine weeks. If a student is wanting an opportunity to increase their final grade, contact the school office at 731-986-8223. Additional assignments are available to students to complete and return to school by Friday, May 8, at 1pm. Any student who failed a class by earning a 65 or higher will be contacted by the school to determine what work he/she will need to complete to gain credit. Any student who earned a final grade less than 65 will be required to retake the class or gain credit through credit recovery next school year.
Credit Recovery	Seniors who need to recover credits will be contacted by the school to let you know what you will need to do to retain credit(s). Underclassmen will resume Credit Recovery at a later date. The school will update you on when Credit Recovery will restart for our underclassmen.
Chromebooks, Textbooks, and Other School Property Drop-Off	Students can begin dropping off school property (Chromebooks, chromebook chargers, textbooks, library books, etc.) on Monday, April 27 from 9am-1pm. We will have school staff available each weekday during these hours to help you with returning items to school. Students should return all school property by Friday, May 15. We will have school staff available to assist you in the front parking lot. T-shirts are also available at Huntingdon Primary School and Huntingdon Middle School for students who ordered shirts.
Graduation	We are hopeful we will be able to give our seniors the graduation they deserve. We anticipate making a decision regarding graduation after discussion with our local school board and reviewing recommendations from our public health officials. information on graduation will be shared as soon as a decision has been made.
Senior Graduation Requirements	Graduation requirements have been amended for seniors by the State Board of Education. Instead of 28 credits, the class of 2020 needs 20 credits (Math-4, English-4, Science-3, History-2, Electives-7) to graduate. The school will contact you if you are in jeopardy of not graduating.
Beta Club Eligibility	Students will not lose Beta Club membership due to pring semester grades. Do not worry about community service hours.
Distinguished Scholar Eligibility	Students will not lose eligibility in the Distinguished Scholar program. Student's status will remain the same as it was at the end of the first semester unless it helped students be removed from probationary status.
Senior Scholarship Deadline	Seniors can submit scholarship applications by Friday, May 1. You can drop off at the school office from 9am-1pm each weekday or email applications to Tracy Connell at <u>tconnell@huntingdonschools.net</u> .

Quarter Classes	HHS offers 4 classes that are for only 9 weeks (Physical Education, Personal Finance, American Government, Economics).
