

## Section 7: COVID Testing Location Options

### **New Mexico Department of Health Coronavirus Hotline 1-855-600-3453**

In order to ensure the best possible care, the hospital systems urge individuals with symptoms and patients scheduled for surgery whose provider has advised them to get tested before the procedure to obtain a test through a private health care provider. Options in Albuquerque include:

- Lovelace Health System is testing at their downtown location Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 7:00AM-10:00AM.
- Presbyterian Healthcare Services is testing at Balloon Fiesta Park, 7:00AM-3:00PM every weekday and 7:00AM-1:00PM on the weekends.
- UNM Hospital is testing at their Respiratory Care Center Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 7:00AM-11:00AM.

In Albuquerque, NMDOH is offering COVID-19 testing at Expo NM Monday-through-Saturday mornings. Individuals who would like to be tested at this location are asked to **pre-register** at <https://cvtestreg.nmhealth.org/Default.aspx>.

Outside of Albuquerque, there are other private testing providers and NMDOH Public Health Offices are open statewide for COVID-19 testing, with some testing events held on weekends. Making an appointment is recommended but not required, and testing is open to anyone concerned about their health. (1) post-secondary educational institutions offering health care instruction, teaching hospitals, and medical schools; (2) community health centers or health centers providing health care to migrants; (3) local health departments or agencies; (4) community mental health centers; (5) not-for-profit hospitals; (6) rural health clinics; (7) skilled nursing facilities; or (8) consortia of health care providers consisting of one or more entities falling into the first seven categories.

An interested entity has to submit an FCC Form 460 to USAC to determine eligibility (information is in the FAQs). Sites that currently participate in RHC have a 460 on file and do not need to do it again.
