2021– 2022 Pre-K Screening – March 5th, 8:30 am – 12:00 pm

Just 4 will be screening students for the 2021-2021 school year. For students to be screened for Pre-K at Just 4, the student must be four-years old on or before September 1, 2021.

All students who will be screened must have an original birth certificate. Parents/guardians must have a photo ID and two proofs of residence. Students may attend screening at only one Pre-K site and complete the on-line application at www.mcpss.com. They must reside in a Title I attendance zone in order to be screened. Your child must complete the onsite screening to be considered for the Mobile County Public School System Pre-K program. If you have any questions or concerns, please call 221-1450.
