

REQUEST FOR ARGUMENTS FOR AND AGAINST THE ISSU-
ANCE OF BONDS BY THE DISTRICT TO BE CONSIDERED
BY THE VOTERS OF THATCHER UNIFIED SCHOOL
DISTRICT NO. 4 OF GRAHAM COUNTY, ARIZONA, AT AN
ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020

Pursuant to a resolution adopted by the Governing Board of Thatcher Unified School District No. 4 of Graham County, Arizona (the "District") on June 25, 2020 (the "Resolution"), a special election in and for the District was ordered and called to be held on November 3, 2020 (the "Election"). Notice of the Election will be given by mailing an informational pamphlet. Such pamphlet is to include arguments for and against the authorization of the issuance of bonds payable from a secondary, ad valorem property tax by the District to be considered at the Election.
