Writing

Do you think people are born artists or can anyone learn to be an artist? Write 3-5 sentences telling me what you think makes an artist.

Creating

Draw something you can use to go somewhere. Draw your bike, hoverboard, car, gator, 4-wheeler, etc.

You should be drawing from life, sit in front of the object and draw it. Do not draw this from your head!

Writing

If you could grow up to be a famous artist what type of art would you make? Write 3-5 sentences telling me if you'd be a painter, potter, graphic artist, sculptor, or weaver and why.

Creating

Draw a self-portrait. Use a mirror and medium of your choice to draw your face.

Remember your head and eyes are ovals, not circles!

New Skill Building II

Come up with a new skill that you haven't learned in art class. Write down what it is and try it at home. For this either turn in what you've made or pictures of you trying a new skill. Think outside the box with things like printmaking, rainbow crayons, and sculpture!

Creating II

Make a found object sculpture. Use yarn, cardboard, clay, whatever you can find! Use glue, string or wire to hold everything together. Your sculpture should stand up on its own.

Writing

Where do artists get their ideas from?

Write 3-5 sentences telling me where you think artists get their ideas from. Then write 1-2 sentences telling me where your art ideas come from.

Creating

Make something using paper products like plates, cups, and tissue tubes.

Paint them, cut them, glue them together, get creative with this one!

Writing

Describe your favorite color.

Write a 3-5 sentences telling me what your favorite color is and why. Where can I find this color in nature? Where else is this color found? Be specific think of colors like grass green or hunter green.
