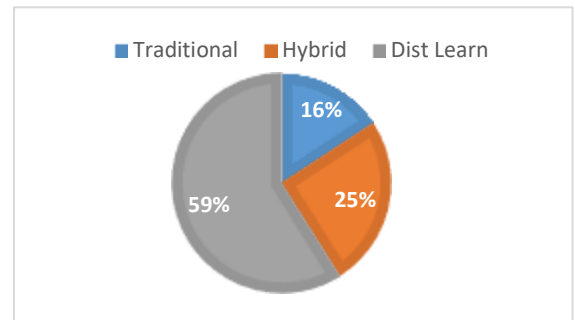
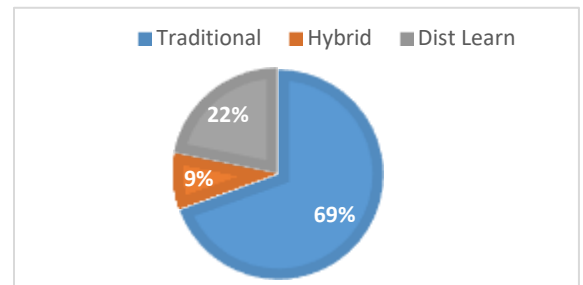

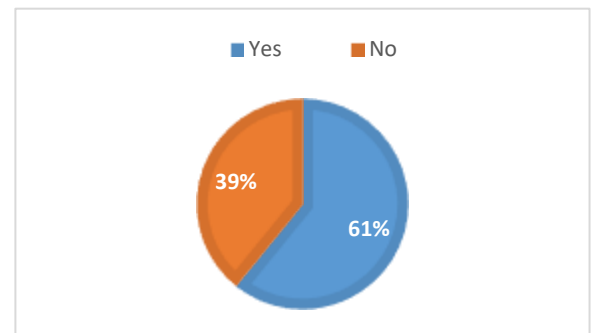
Which of the following would you MOST prefer for the first few weeks of the new school year?



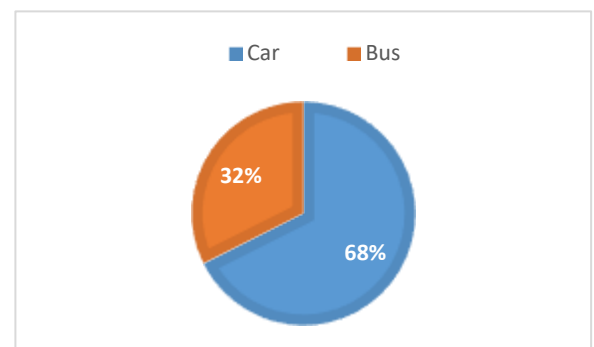
