The Randolph County Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, August 15, 2011 at 6 p.m. in the Central Office Board Room.

Call to Order

District Accreditation Release

Mrs. Pat Foust, Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction, presented to B. Coltrane, Board Chair and Mr. Andrews, Superintendent a certificate awarding initial district accreditation with the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Council on Accreditation and School Improvement (SACSCASI). Ms. Foust stated the term of accreditation is through June 30, 2016.

2011 Graduation Statistical Information

Mrs. Kim Johnson, Director of Secondary Education, shared 2011 Graduation Statistical Information: 1,116 diplomas were issued, 22 certificates were issued, 37.63% are going to public and/or private four-year colleges, 46.42% are going to community colleges, private junior colleges, and trade schools; 4.84% are entering the military, and 10.22% are entering the workforce. The total monies awarded to Randolph County graduates toward furthering their education was \$22,672,721.00. Also mentioned was the new partnership with National Clearing Student House that will begin with this year's senior class to track students after high school.

Testing and Accountability

Dr. Sharon Johnson, Director of Testing and Accountability, presented ABC preliminary data. Dr. Johnson reviewed major achievements with students making positive progress on both EOG and several EOC tests with RCS performance composite showing a gain from 2010. Dr. Johnson gave an overview of the 2011 EOG and EOC results and ABC comparisons from 2002-2011. Accomplishments: 77% of our schools met or exceeded growth expectations compared to 71% in 2010; 6 percentage point increase in the number of schools meeting growth expectations with the state showing a 6.6% point drop in the number of schools meeting growth expectations. Challenges and next steps were also reviewed.

2012-2013 Calendar

Mr. Marty Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations, reviewed the 2012-2013 revised school calendar recommendation due to the five additional state required student days. The calendar will be placed on the RCS webpage to give parents and community a chance to give input with the final calendar recommendation being presented to the Board at the September Board meeting.
