

This year we will be using Class Dojo for behavior management in our classrooms. By using this digital platform we are allowing parents to see both the positive and negative behaviors of their child each day. The students will earn points for positive behaviors daily and any negative behaviors your child earns will deduct points from their weekly total.


Expectations

1. Respect others & their property.
2. Remain on task & complete assignments without distracting others.
3. Come to class with necessary materials.
4. Tell the truth & do your best!

Rewards

Students should earn 6 positive points each day. These include: completed work for math, science/ss, reading, grammar/spelling, and being prepared (bringing the correct materials from one room to their next class). Students can also earn extra points for outstanding behavior. The DOJO points will show how many minutes of Fun Friday each child receives. Any points over 30 can be banked for future rewards.

Here's a look at the positives



Tiered Offense per week	Rewards
Student Dojo point total is between 25-29	25 minutes of Fun Friday and opportunity to earn back Dojo points
Student Dojo point total is between 20 - 24	20 minutes of Fun Friday Opportunities to earn back Dojo points
Student Dojo point total is between 15-19	15 minutes of Fun Friday Opportunities to earn back Dojo points
Student Dojo point total is between 10 - 14	10 minutes of Fun Friday and opportunities to earn back Dojo points
Student Dojo point total is between 5-9 : less than 5 points earns 0 minutes of Fun Friday and office referral	5 minutes of Fun Friday and the opportunity to earn back Dojo points



Consequences

Each nine weeks the students' DOJO points will restart. The following information shows the order in which consequences for poor behavior will be documented, communicated to parents, and if needed, communicated to the Assistant Principal.

- 1.) If a student does what he/she is supposed to do each day they should receive 30 DOJO points. So if a student only receives half those points, 15pts, parents will be contacted and the teacher will start the office referral.
- 2.) The second time a student receives 15pts or less in a week the parents will have a conference with the teachers.
- 3.) The third time a student receives 15pts or less in a week the teachers will turn in a office referral to the assistant principal.

Students can lose points for unacceptable behavior. Please note that some infractions are -1pt while others are -3pts. The infractions that are -3pts are considered more severe and therefore carry more weight than a less severe offence.
