



## Updated LHS Varsity Basketball Fan Procedures, 2020-2021



The AHSAA and ALSDE have issued new mandates on 12/14 that will only allow 20% capacity for in-door sporting events. This will limit our gym capacity to approximately 80 spectators (does not include players, coaches, cheerleaders). In order to follow these new mandates and to ensure that immediate family are able to see their child play we will begin implementing the following procedures for Varsity Basketball game attendance when playing at LHS.

We will play 3 Home games at the Ozark Civic Center. Those dates are listed at the bottom of page. There will be **NO** capacity restrictions for the games played at the Civic Center and all tickets (home and visitor) will be sold at the door for these games. Mask and social distancing will still be required.

### Ticketing Procedures when playing at LHS

- **NO tickets will be sold at the door**
- LHS Basketball Players will be allowed to purchase up to 3 tickets for their respective team's game minus the immediate family that get in with a pass (i.e. coaching card, teacher pass, etc...)
  - Tickets will be sold one - two days prior to the upcoming Home Game
  - Each team will have their own ticket color which will only be good for that respective team's game
  - **Tickets are \$6**
  - Families that have children playing on multiple teams will only be required to purchase one ticket per person and will be given the other respective ticket(s) at **NO** additional charge
- LHS Cheerleaders scheduled to cheer will be allowed to purchase up to 2 tickets for the games they are cheering.
  - These tickets will be sold one - two days prior to the upcoming Home game and will cover all the games that the cheerleaders are cheering for.
  - **Tickets are \$6**
- **Entry will only be allowed to the game you have purchased a ticket for**
- Home and Visiting Teams will be limited to **6 cheerleaders** and will have designated seating.
- Every other row will be taped off to allow for social distancing.
- We ask that fans keep a 6 foot distance from the playing surface to allow for adequate distance between fans and those playing/officiating
- Seating behind the Home and Visitor Benches will be reserved for players and team personnel only.
- The gym will be cleared after each game to ensure we maintain capacity numbers
- Masks are required at all games
