

Greetings Scholarship Applicant,

The following instructions are provided for the 2021 Kiwanis Club of Warner Robins College Scholarship.

- 1) Kiwanis Club of Warner Robins will award two \$1,500 scholarships. Graduating students at Warner Robins High School, Northside High School, Veterans High School or Houston County High School are eligible to apply.
- 2) **Purpose:** The annual scholarships are offered with the purpose of providing financial assistance to deserving students who have a financial need and a desire to further his or her education beyond high school
- 3) **Qualifications:** The scholarships are available to high school seniors of the 2021 graduating class of one of the following high schools: Warner Robins High School, Northside High School, Veterans High School or Houston County High School. The applicant must also have the necessary qualifications for acceptance by an accredited college or university of his or her choice.
- 4} **Application Package:** Two copies of the following documents must be received with each application package:
- a) A complete and signed application form (application is attached).
- b) Two letters of recommendation from someone other than a family member.
- c) High School Transcript (Obtained from your school)
- d) College acceptance letter **or** typed acknowledgement of where you applied for admission
- e) Two completed short essays as listed on Page 4 of the application
- 5) **Deadline (April 15, 2021):** All application packages must be received by April 15, 2021 or contain a postmark mailing date no later than April 15, 2021. Application packages should be mailed to the following address: **Kiwanis Club of Warner Robins. Attn: 2021 Scholarship Committee, P. O. Box 6296, Warner Robins, GA 31095** Application packages will be evaluated based on the information received in the package, to include the information on the application form, the written short essays and the letters of recommendation.

All scholarship funds awarded will be disbursed for the fall semester. All checks will be made payable to the college or university that the student plans to attend.
