FR: Extension of Spring Break (March 16 – April 3, 2020)

This is to communicate to all stakeholders and constituents of Shonto Preparatory School that informs the extension of Spring Break from March 16 – April 3, 2020 for all students enrolled at Shonto Preparatory School (K-8) and for Shonto Technology High School. This includes all ten (10) month employees who provide instructional services to our students. The extension of Spring Break is due to the current state of emergency for the Navajo Nation and for the State of Arizona.

Health and safety is a priority for all students, staff, and family members at Shonto Preparatory School. We must continue to use healthy measures such as:

- 1) Washing your hands with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds or more
- 2) Keeping your home and living spaces clean
- 3) Visiting your local health professional (doctor) when feeling sick
- 4) Staying away from large groups of people and limiting traveling to other areas
- 5) Covering your coughs using your elbow and not your hands
- 6) Use hand sanitizers when available

There will also be a restriction to student and staff travel in and out of the state of Arizona. All school and non-school sponsored events are cancelled due to the state of emergency. School will tentatively resume on April 6, 2020. Keep up on all district updates by visiting the school web page: www.shontoprep.org. Twelve (12) month employees are to report to work as scheduled.

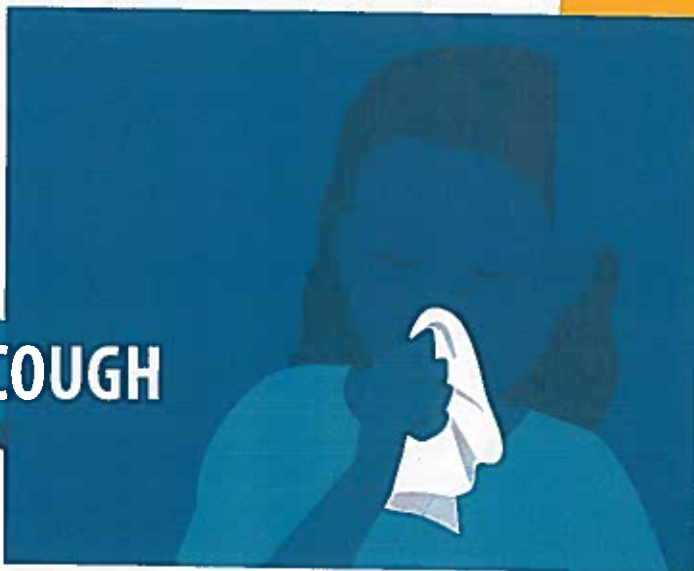
Patients with COVID-19 have experienced mild to severe respiratory illness.
