1. E-SPLOST Discussion

- *Education Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax
- *1% sales tax on the dollar to fund capital projects or retire debt for Houston County Schools
- *Current E-SPLOST ends March 31st, 2022
- *2022-2027 referendum asks to continue the E-SPLOST for five years or if a cap of 190 million dollars is reached-whichever comes first
- *Continuation of E-SPLOST will provide funds for:
 - -improving safety and security
 - -facilities improvement
 - -technology
 - -transportation
- *The special election vote will be held March 16th, with early voting being offered February 22nd-March 12th
- *The E-SPLOST has been continually renewed since approximately 2002

2. Upcoming School Projects

- *Four flower pots in the front of school need to get planted
 - -2-3 people could help
 - -Project completion can happen during the school day
- *Shed-BPS has a shed in the back for equipment storage that needs painting
 - -Approximately 6 people needed to assist
- -Must be done on a weekend to allow time for paint to dry since the shed is located in proximity to the playground
 *Trash pick-up
 - -Due to students eating snacks outside, there is a lot of trash that ends up near the fence line from the wind
 - -One suggestion was to contact groups needing community service projects to assist with cleanup

- -One idea was to create a work day, possibly Saturday, March 20th to accomplish all of the school projects. The event could include selling of BPS shirts and magnets, having food trucks on site, etc.
- -Another idea was to create multiple weekend trash clean up days throughout the school year

 - *Staff also receive emails with the same information
