

Policy

LOITERING OR CAUSING DISTURBANCES

Any person who is not a member of the school staff or student body and who loiters in, on, or about any school building or grounds without written permission, or any person, member of the staff or student body who causes disturbances may be prosecuted according to law.

In addition, each principal and the superintendent possess the authority to prohibit the entry of any person into a school of this district or to remove any person from the school when there is reason to believe the presence of such person would be detrimental to the good order of the school. If such a person refuses to leave the school grounds or creates a disturbance, the principal or superintendent shall request assistance from local law enforcement to remove the person.
