## Compulsory School Attendance

### Referral Process

- Mississippi law requires all individuals between the ages of six (6) and seventeen (17) to enroll in and attend school. This law also applies to all five-year old students enrolled in a full-time public kindergarten program.
- Student misses five (5) cumulative unexcused days. Report to School Attendance Officer, who will attempt to secure attendance with a letter, home visit, and or letter.
- Student misses twelve (12) cumulative unexcused days. Report to School Attendance Officer, will attempt with to secure attendance with a letter, home visit, and or letter.
- Once ALL attempts have been made, the School Attendance Officer may file a petition in youth, city, county, or justice court.
- Suspensions are unexcused absences and must be reported as they occur.

## IF YOUR FAMILY LIVES IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SITUATIONS:

- ♦ In a shelter
- ♦ In a motel or campground due to the lack of an alternative adequate accommodation
- ♦ In a car, park, abandoned building, or bus or train station
- ♦ Doubled up with other people due to loss of housing or economic hardship (Please Contact your Parent Liaison)
