Tasks:

- ✓ Tasks:
- ✓ Check Technology to ensure TestNav update is loaded in your devices, students have individual passwords to access computer and internet, and devices are charged and ready for testing. Run APP checks on as many devices as possible. **Make sure students use the same device for each testing session.**
- ✓ Ensure that procedures are set and understood for distribution and submission of devices, authorization tickets, and testing irregularities.
- ✓ Ensure test administrators and proctors have testing procedures, have been trained and have signed the security agreements, TAs have a copy of the test schedule, test administration script and PNP Summary.
- ✓ Check that all test sessions are set and all students are scheduled into a test.
- ✓ Meet with your assessment team to ensure all preparations are complete.
- ✓ DO NOT CLOSE TEST SESSIONS UNTIL ALL STUDENTS IN THE SESSION HAVE TESTING OR WITH FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS FROM DTC.
- ✓ Make sure room is prepared; all anchor charts and visual aids covered, and testing signs posted.
- ✓ All students need to be facing the same direction and toward the wall clock. Internet timers may not be used. Students should be 3ft. apart from head to head.
