- Ashley Flukinger Scholarship: Ashley is a 2003 graduate of Seaside High School. She graduated from Oregon State in 2007 with a Bachelor of Science, and then from Willamette University Law School in 2011 with a Juris Doctor. She now practices law in Seaside. The recipient of this \$500 scholarship will be somebody who has demonstrated strong leadership, academic excellence, involvement in school activities, and involvement in community service.
- Bob Mork Memorial Scholarship: This \$500 scholarship was established as a memorial for Bob Mork, an avid supporter of all school and community activities. As a past Booster Club president, he always made sure that all sports and activities at SHS received support. Giving students the opportunity to attend college was very important to him. The scholarship may be used at any 2 or 4-year college, university or technical program. Criteria: Involvement in extracurricular activities, community involvement and academic achievement (no GPA requirement).
- Bridget Vellutini Athletic Scholarship: This \$500 scholarship was established in April, 1994, as a memorial for Bridget Vellutini, a four year, three-sport athlete at Seaside High School from 1987-1991. Bridget lettered in volleyball, basketball and track. She died in an automobile accident in January 1994. This scholarship is established so that a female athlete at SHS may be assisted in attending a two-or four-year college to compete in athletics. The scholarship will be paid during the second term. Criteria: Female SHS graduating student; lettered in varsity athletics and wants to compete in college athletics; financial need. Additional Requirements: Provide an athletic resume listing all sports, honors, awards camps and community involvement. Answer the following: 1) what will be your involvement in athletics, both formal and informal, after you graduate? 2) Give the following information about the sports you will compete in at college: Sport, Coach, Letter of Intent Signed? Walk-on?
- **Bruce and Treva Haskell Memorial Scholarship:** This is a continuing scholarship in memory of Mr. Bruce Haskell. Amount of the award is **\$500**. The money can be used for educational expenses at any trade/technical or business school, two or four year institution. The money will be distributed equally over the course of one year of study. **Criteria:** Graduating SHS senior; community service; financial need; goals and future plans; extra-curricular activities; HS record (not GPA).
- Byron Meek "The Program" Scholarship: Byron Meek was a longtime Seaside resident who enjoyed many years of productive community service. In 1995, he authored, "The Program", to encourage fifth grade students to do positive activities rather than become involved in the negatives, such as drugs, alcohol, tobacco and gangs. One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded. Criteria: Graduating SHS senior who participated in "The Program" at Seaside Heights as a 5<sup>th</sup> grade student. Additional Requirements: Please attach a sheet to your application responding to the following: Write an essay 1) describing your community involvement, events, and service projects you were involved in that directly impacted our community;

2) reflecting upon your Program pledge to avoid alcohol, drugs, tobacco and gang involvement since 5<sup>th</sup> grade;

3) sharing limitations and/or challenges you've had to face; and

4) regarding your financial need and fiscal plan for continuing your education beyond high school.
