Dear Frazier Parents/Guardians,

Today, Governor Tom Wolf announced that all K-12 Pennsylvania schools will be closed for 10 business days effective Monday March 16- Friday March 27, 2020. The administration has been working with school districts as well as state and local officials to gather input on this decision. The Wolf Administration will continue to monitor Covid-19 in the commonwealth, and at the end of 10 days will reevaluate and decide whether continued closure is needed.

In an effort to support our students and families during this time, the district will have free take-out lunches available Monday-Friday from 11:00am-12:00pm beginning Monday, March 16, 2020- Friday, March 27, 2020. Meals may be picked up at the Middle School front entrance. To help us estimate meal counts, please call 724-736-9507x431 by 12:00pm the day prior to notify the district that your child will be picking up a take-out lunch.

During district closure, we will be suspending all activities for the duration of the two-week period. All district facilities, including athletic facilities will be unavailable for use until further notice.

During this time, we are recommending you review the information located at [www.pa.gov](http://www.pa.gov) with your child and family members to help prevent the spread of this virus. These are trying times for all involved. We need to support one another and take the appropriate steps needed to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of our friends, families, and community members.
