- One IB course with a C or higher and take the appropriate IB exams
- One academic dual credit course earning a C or higher

Requirements for Early Release

Students who have not met the Mississippi postsecondary ACT remediation benchmarks of 17 in English and 19 in Math or SAT equivalency or the Silver level on the ACT WorkKeys for the CTE endorsement must meet ALL 4 of the following requirements for early release

- have the required 2.5 GPA
- have passed or met all MAAP assessments requirements for graduation
- be on track to meet diploma requirements
- be concurrently enrolled in Essentials for College Math and/or Essentials for College Literacy
