

MINUTES
AUTAUGA COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION
DECEMBER 8, 2020

The Autauga County Board of Education met in a regular session on Tuesday, December 8, 2020. Board Chairman Jeffrey Keith called the meeting to order at 5:33 p.m. with all board members present. Mr. Keith gave the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance followed.
