The Frazier Summer Learning Program is for current students in grades K-8. Students will explore math, reading, and STEM/STEAM throughout the 4-week program and will rotate through sessions each day starting at 9:00AM and ending at 2:00PM. Each week will focus on a different theme. Students must attend all day. Lunch and snacks will be provided.

- Transportation will be provided by the district **for Frazier students only.**
- Technology will be provided by the district **for Frazier students only.**
