The Pool contract, replacement of school vehicles, and possible addition of a P.E./Health position at the High School were discussed.


Participation at the upcoming MSBA Phase Training and January Conference were discussed.


The upcoming Reorganizational Meeting was discussed as well as the vision for the District. MREA ballots were completed.
