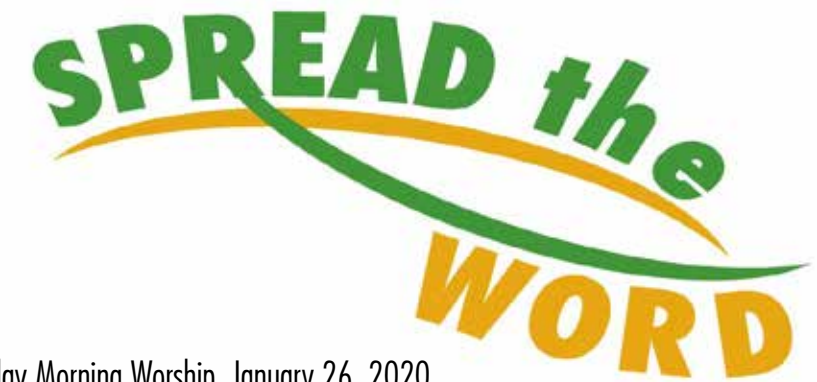

HAGGAI

In the Bible, the stacking of stone on top of stone in the shape of the temple was a sign that God's people were supposed to look outside of themselves and to the place where the Lord dwelt among them. After the temple was destroyed, many believers turned more inwardly focused on themselves than before. God's people returned and started rebuilding the temple, but as soon as they stopped stacking those stones one on top of the other, they began to focus more and more inwardly again. In today's message, Haggai is going to remind the people that the stones stacked together to make the temple are a constant reminder that as long as the temple exists, they should be focusing on God and His care for them. Today, as we know that Jesus' body is the resurrected temple, we too should acknowledge that we need our very selves renewed to focus on Jesus and His care for us.
