Early College vs. Career and College Promise

Early College Students...

Unique Experient

- Begin college coursework in their 9th grade year
- Can enroll in most RCC courses
- Choose from an Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, Associate of Applied Science, or diplomas or certificates

CCP Students...

- Begin college coursework in their 11th grade year
- Must complete shortened pathways prior to pursuing a full associate degree
- Must prove college readiness prior to starting a program



How is RECHS different?
