

District and School Use of NSLA Funding 2014-2015

In accordance with A.C.A. § 6-20-2305(b)(4)(C), Pottsville School District utilized NSLA funding for the following eligible uses during the school year 2014-2015:

- Classroom teachers: K-3 science teacher, language arts (reading) teacher 8th grade
- Materials & supplies for neglected or homeless students not served by Title I
- Instructional Facilitator (HQT) to collaborate, organize instructional materials, collect student data, monitor individual student progress
- Math materials and supplies to help increase student achievement
- READ 180 Program-for struggling readers below proficient level with differentiated instruction, adaptive and instructional software, high-interest literature, and direct instruction in reading, writing, and vocabulary skills
- Electronic reading devices and audio books to improve reading comprehension, decoding skills, and fluency
- Materials and supplies for CAPS/PT Conferences
- Paraprofessionals to assist supplemental instruction in reading and math
- Interactive lab materials and supplies
- Accelerated reader/literacy/practical texts books and supplies
- Raptor software – parent involvement / student security
- Parent Involvement materials and supplies
- SmartBoards, Projectors, and Chromebooks to provide students with multimedia capabilities and hands-on activities
- Overdrive Program to assist students of varied learning styles to increase their reading comprehension through audio books and e-books
