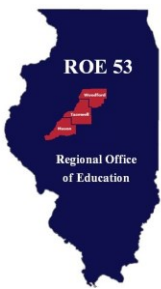

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4. **State-mandated trainings for PD hours:** ISBE, IARSS, and a few other stakeholders convened last week to discuss whether or not state-mandated trainings should be allowable hours toward educator licensure renewal. After a robust discussion and weighing of pros and cons, the group decided that **certain training topics do align with state law requirements for professional development**, and a sub-group will convene in early November at ISBE to create a guidance document outlining applicable trainings that may count for professional development hours. Ultimately, **providers may offer any trainings for professional development hours but must ensure that the trainings are robust enough to fulfill all requirements for professional development set forth in state law and Administrative Code**. ISBE recommends that providers **continue business as usual** when offering mandated trainings until this guidance document is released next month.

Districts as Providers

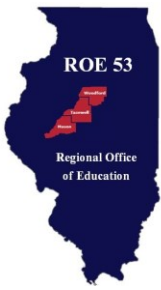
Can I issue activity hours for it?

- For each activity, the participant should fill this out and give it to admin for approval.
 - ISBE PD Activity Summary Form - Can I count it as PD?

What evidence does the educator need to count if audited? They need either...

- 1) Evidence of Completion form 77-21B **OR...**
- 2) Transcript from IL junior college, or IL college/university with an ISBE approved teacher preparation program.
- **These are the only 2 forms of evidence that are acceptable to ISBE in the event of an audit. If these are not present, the PD will not count towards the PD requirement for the educator.**
- Districts can issue 77-21B for coursework from a out-of-state college/university (15 PD hours/credit hour - Ex. 3 hour class = 45 PD hours)

Districts are providers so they can issue the 77-21B for activities that educators do outside of the district, if you warrant that it is good PD using the ISBE Activity Summary.



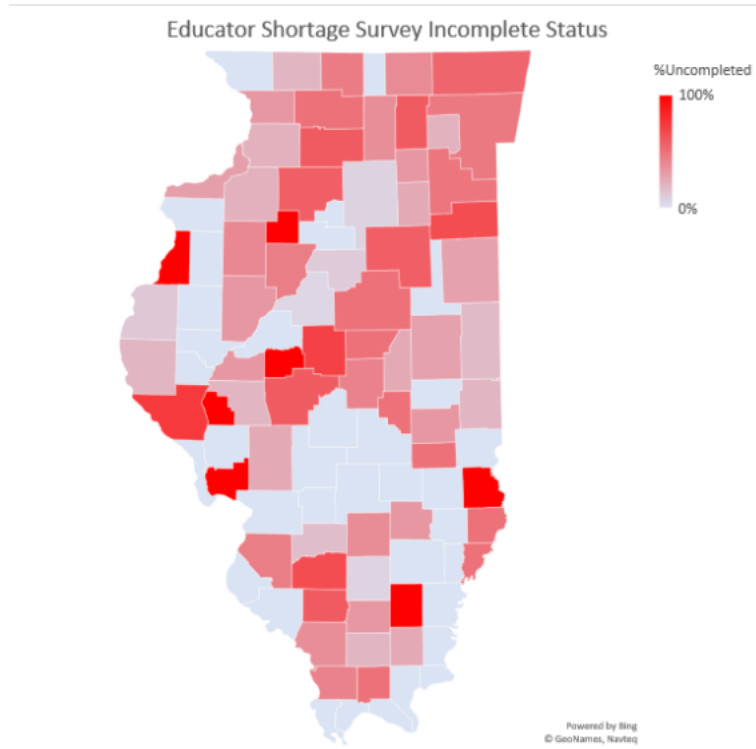
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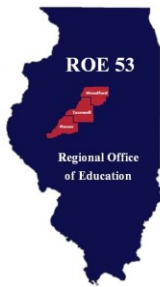

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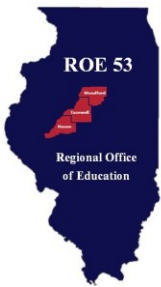
