2018 – 2019 Meal Prices for Chester County Schools

All Chester County School students will receive “Universal Free Breakfast”

STUDENT LUNCH:

Pre-K – 5<sup>th</sup> grade: \$2.00

6<sup>th</sup> grade – 12<sup>th</sup> grade: \$2.25

VISITOR meals cannot be charged

CHILDREN: \$2.00

ADULT: \$4.50

Holiday meals for Visitors \$4.50

A student may charge meals on an emergency basis at all Chester County School Cafeterias. After a negative balance is reached, letters will be sent home to the parent/guardian requesting payment.

Chester County Students will not be refused a meal.
