♦ CCRPI gains for Miller Elementary were from 68.5 to a 76

✤ Miller Elementary is adding another self-contained autism classroom. Therefore, Miller is hiring another teacher and Para-professional for that classroom.

✤ In March, surveys will go home to parents and student surveys of the school will be distributed. The student surveys are distributed to third through fifth graders. Teacher surveys will also be distributed at this time.

During our meeting we discussed many important upcoming events such as in January report cards go home to parents on January 9, 2018. Mrs. Johnson explained that the WAG crew is a group of male students, about twelve boys. Mrs. Miliner, the assistant principal for discipline, spearheads this group. Mrs. Miliner has planned for the Macon Mayhem hockey players to come to Miller Elementary and meet and speak to the boys. Mr. Canion asked for a flyer explaining the objectives of the group. Also in January, the ESOL teacher has prepared an ESOL Parent Night on January 11th. This event will have a translator available. This event will provide parents with information about community resources available to them.
