

MINUTES
AUTAUGA COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION
OCTOBER 27, 2020

The Autauga County Board of Education met in a special session on Tuesday, October 27, 2020. Board Chairman Mark Hindman called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. with all board members present. Mr. Greg Gray gave the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance followed.

The agenda for the meeting was approved on a motion by Mr. Manderson, seconded by Ms. Goodwin.

Mr. Hindman opened the meeting to allow board members to place nominations on the table for discussion of the superintendent candidates. Mr. Manderson nominated Mr. Timothy Tidmore. Mr. Manderson discussed the reasons he would like to see Mr. Tidmore as the superintendent. Ms. Goodwin, Ms. Ballow, and Mr. Hindman added their comments. Ms. Goodwin nominated Dr. Greg DeJarnett and Dr. Penny Johnson. Ms. Goodwin discussed the reasons she would like to see either candidate as superintendent. Ms. Ballow expressed her thoughts on both candidates. Mr. Hindman asked each board member to place the name of their top candidate on a note card. Mr. Hindman, Ms. Ballow, Mr. Keith, and Mr. Manderson all voted for Mr. Tidmore. Ms. Goodwin voted for Dr. Johnson. With the majority being for Mr. Tidmore, the board voted to enter into contract negotiations with Mr. Tidmore along side the board attorney with a unanimous vote on a motion by Mr. Manderson, seconded by Ms. Goodwin.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Mr. Keith.
