Jump Rope

Jump rope is an incredible lifetime fitness activity! Athletes use rope jumping for agility, timing, coordination, foot-speed and endurance. Learning the skill early in life helps develop the skills for a lifetime of rope jumping for fun and fitness. Researchers are learning that physical activity like jumping rope also prepares the brain for optimal learning too. So, it's great for the mind, body and the soul!
