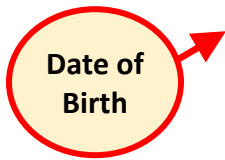


Student Google Accounts

On your computer, go to <https://google.com/>. A student's email is their lunch ID followed by @havasuoonline.org. For example: 123123@havasuoonline.org.

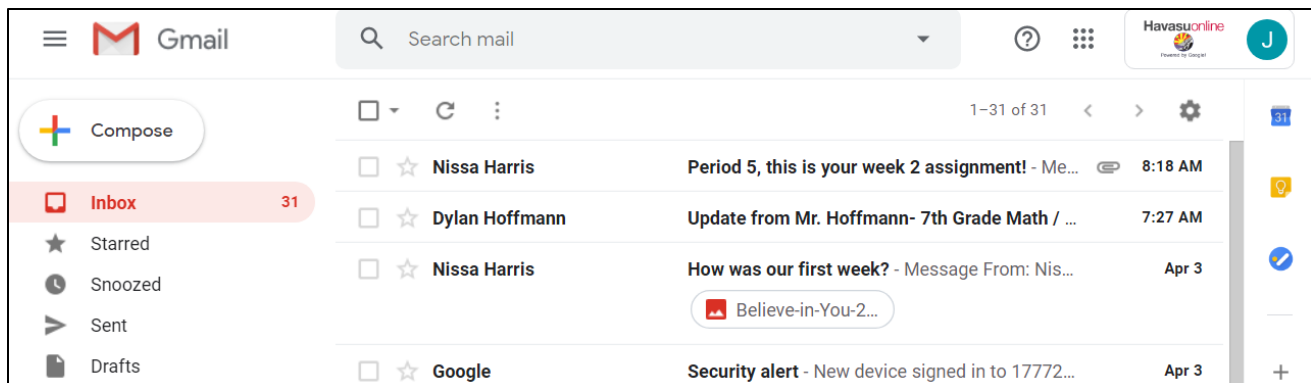
Your student's initial password will be their birthdate in this format:



YYYYMMDD

Example: A birthday of May 2, 2007 will look like this 20070502

Once successfully signed in, the home page is your student's gmail inbox.



If your student is having trouble signing in, follow the link below to request a password reset or assistance. All passwords will be reset to 123456789 when a request is made.

If we reset your password, we would like students to use their birthday followed by their first initial and last initial for the password. This way they are less likely to forget them, and we are in a better position to help if problems arise. Password formatting looks like this:

YYYYMMDD<firstinitial><lastinitial>

Example: 20050206ng

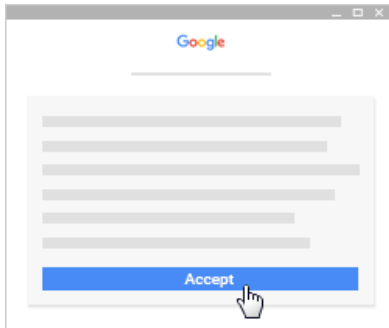
Depending upon the demand, it may take a few hours to reset your account. Please wait about an hour after your request and then periodically try to sign in until you are successful.

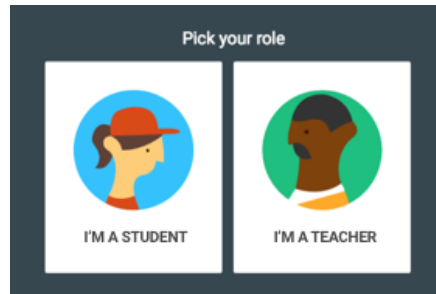
Google Classroom Accounts

Go to <https://accounts.google.com/ServiceLogin/> and sign in using the havasuonline.org email and password.

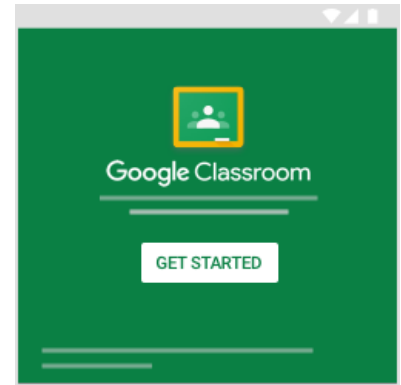
1. If there is a welcome message, read it and click Accept.




2. Click I'm A Student

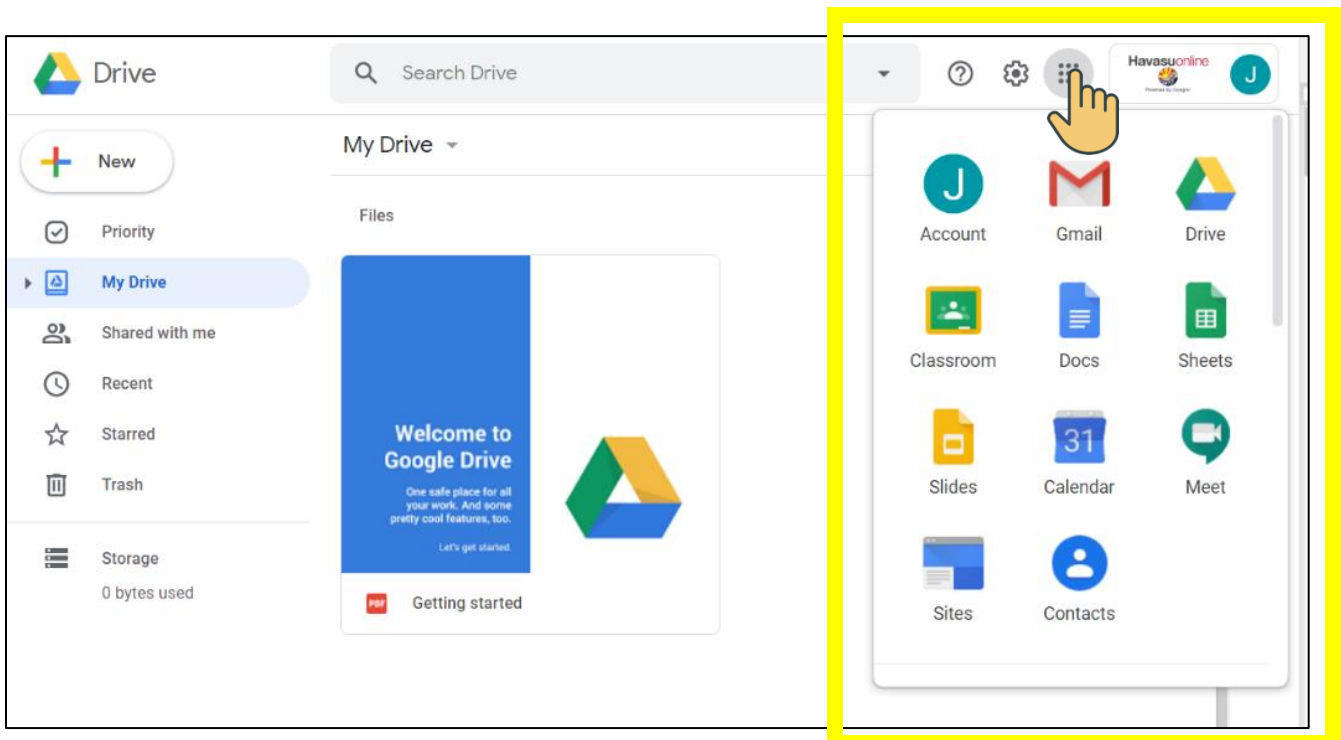


3. Click Get Started.

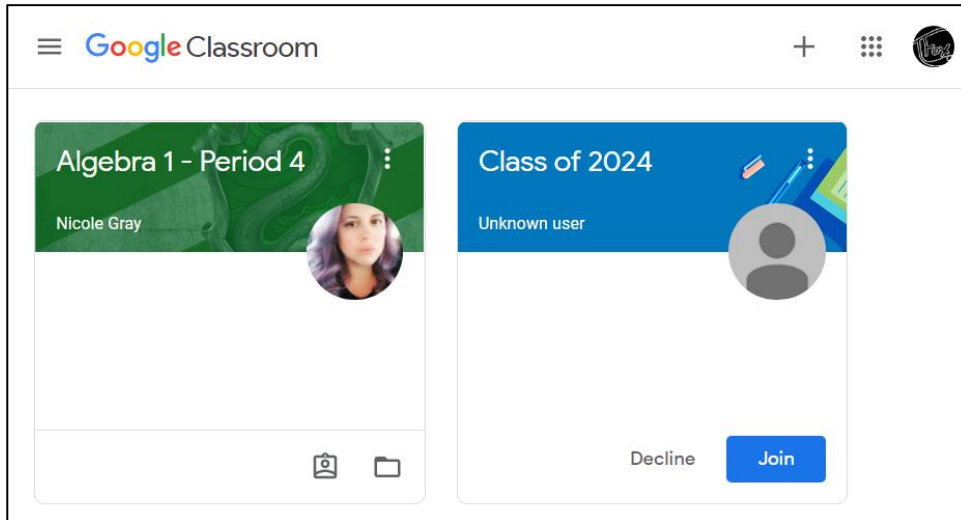


4. In the upper right hand corner, use the dot grid icon  to navigate around. Click on it to see the menu.

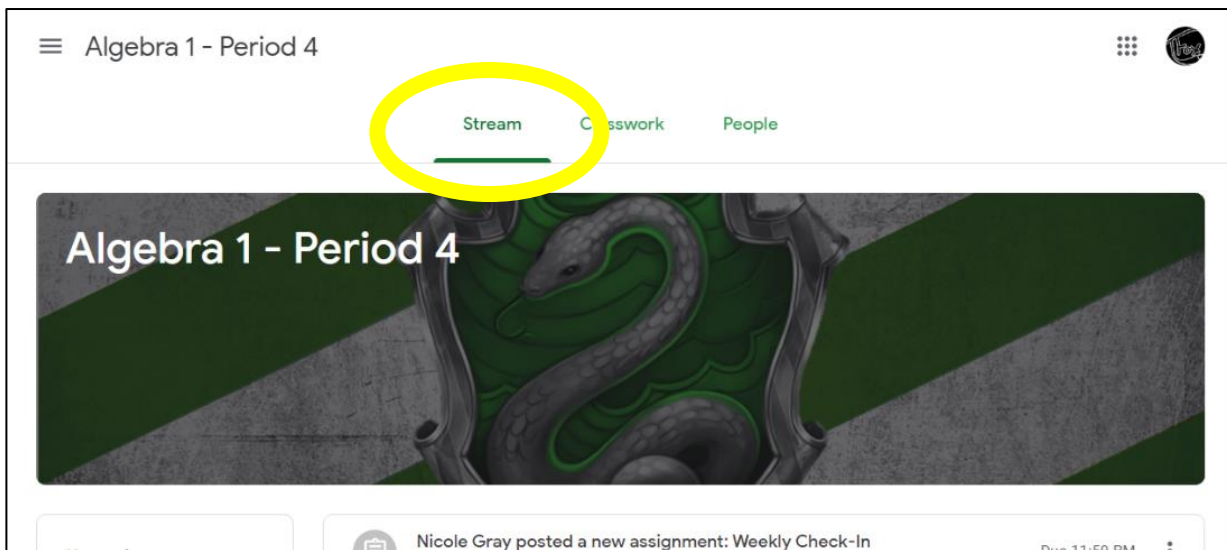
- Gmail – Check your email from teachers.
- Classroom—Students, navigate to any of your classes.
- Calendar—Students, see your class calendars.
- Drive – Store your files, sync with other devices, and share files.
- Classwork—Students, go to see your work for a class.

Stream – To see the latest work and announcements.



Classwork – To see work arranged by topic
