

The Webster County Board of Education recognizes the value and importance of using County school buses in all areas of the total school program. For efficiency of operation and safety of school children, the following requirements must be met to use school buses for extra-curricular and school-related activities.

1. A request for the use of a bus must be processed through and approved by the Superintendent or his/her designee prior to the scheduled activity.
2. The driver should be a regular Webster County school bus driver.

Transportation of the Elderly, Handicapped and Other Requests

Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary relating to school funds, the Webster County Board of Education may use school buses to provide transportation for the elderly, handicapped, 4-H activities, summer camps, or participation in other recreational or educational activities if the cost of such transportation is reimbursed in full from federal, state, local or other funds, other than school funds.

In a state of emergency, the Superintendent is authorized to commit school buses for use by emergency organizations as needed to meet the common good. Drivers should be employees of the Webster County Board of Education.
