All students in grades 4th through 12th will have access to Google Apps for Education in the classroom. Google Apps for Education is a suite of free, web-based programs that includes email, document creation, calendars, and collaboration tools. Students will have a stark100.com email account that will be limited to sending and receiving with other stark100.com addresses.

Stark County CUSD #100 uses an internet filter for online protection against inappropriate use, but parents will be responsible for monitoring their child's use when accessing Google Apps from home. Students are responsible for their online behavior at all times.

Google Apps for Education is also available at home, the library or anywhere there is Internet access. School staff will monitor student use of Google Apps when students are at school.
