Thank you for purchasing this “Identifying Feelings/How Does He/She Feel and Why?” activity.

This activity focuses on the feelings happy, sad, angry, confused, surprised, excited, proud, and scared with the use of twelve situational pictures, with a short listening selection, a fill-in sentence and feelings visual icon choices. The student is to identify the feeling of the character and the reason for those feelings. The feelings icons on each page provides the student with a visual cue to help him/her decide how the character feels. The “reason for the character’s feelings” is underlined within the listening selection to provide another visual cue. The last page is a bigger version of the feelings visual that you can use in conjunction with the other pages, in case the student needs larger icons.

# Preparation & Use

You will need:

- ✧ Printer
- ✧ Standard White Printer Paper, 8.5" x 11"
- ✧ Laminate for 13 pages.

Prepare by printing and laminating the 13 activity pages.

Use:

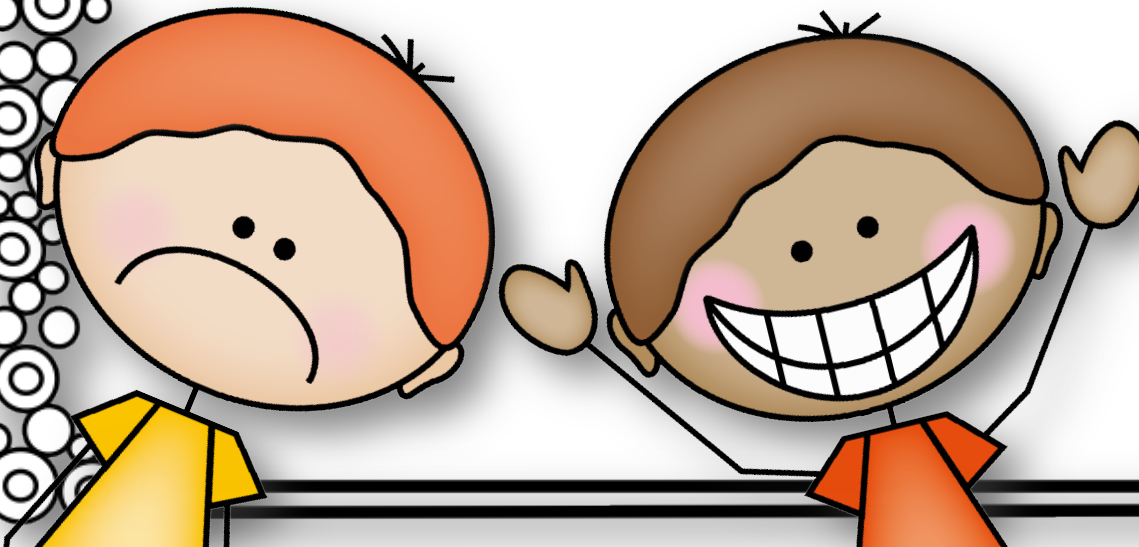
- Read the short listening selection. With the appropriate support, talk about the situation in the story/picture. Ask the student to look at the face of the character and ask about the feelings.
- Proceed to read the fill-in sentence and prompt the student for the "feelings" and "reason for the feelings."
- Keep practicing these pages with the student and adjust your support as needed. Eventually, the student should be able to say the fill-in sentence on his/her own.
- Answer Key: happy, angry, excited, silly, proud, sad, confused, surprised, scared, excited, sad, embarrassed.



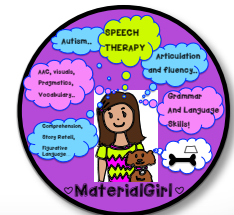
