

Good evening elementary school parents and students of the Randolph County School System,

This is Stephen Gainey. I want to make you aware of the following information:

At the Board of Education meeting on 10/19/20, a change was made to the plan announced on 10/15/20 for students in grades PreK-5. More specifically, at the Board of Education meeting on 10/19/20, a decision was made to allow all PreK students and students in grades K-5 to return to school for four days per week on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday starting on 10/26/20. Wednesday will remain as a “remote instruction day” for these students.

Please note that your child should continue to follow his or her current school schedule through the end of the day on 10/23/20. Also, students scheduled to start attending school for 5 days of face-to-face instruction per week on 10/26/20 will automatically be moved to the schedule with 4 days of face-to-face instruction and 1 remote instruction day. However, if a parent wants to change from this plan to 100% remote instruction, he or she should notify his or her child’s school no later than 10/23/20.

After 10/23/20, the only change that a student can make during the remainder of the time that our school system deals with the COVID-19 pandemic is to return to school for four days of face-to-face instruction and 1 day of remote instruction per week.
