As a parent of a child at a Title I school in Hardee County, you have the right to know the qualifications of your child's teacher. Specifically, you have the right to ask for and receive the following information:

- If they meet the qualifications for the grades and subjects taught;
- If they are working under emergency or provisional status;
- Their college major and any advanced degrees,
- The subject area of their certification or degree; and
- If paraprofessionals provide services to your child and, if so, their qualifications.

In addition, parents have the following rights and responsibilities:

- To be involved in their child's school; and
- To provide input in the plans and policies of your child's school.

If you would like to receive any of this information or have questions, you may contact the administration at your child's school.

You will be notified in writing if your child has been assigned or has been taught for more than four consecutive weeks by a non-state certified teacher.
