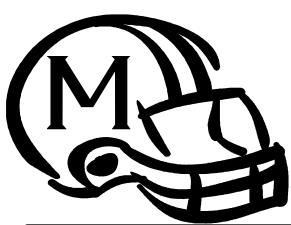

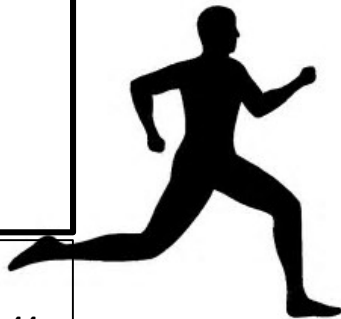
## Varsity Boys
