



CGE Study Abroad Code of Conduct Agreement

I, as a participant in the Consortium of Global Education's (CGE) Study Abroad program, agree to abide by the following rules of conduct. I hereby affirm and agree that if I violate this Code of Conduct, disciplinary measures may be taken against me. If I commit any violations that are deemed by CGE's stateside directors, home campus directors, and CGE's local director, to be a serious violation of this Code of Conduct, I recognize and accept that I may be expelled from the program. I would forfeit my right to a refund of any and all moneys paid.

1. I will respect the security guidelines of the CGE Study Abroad program. I will limit my movements to the CGE study locations, local university campus, or approved housing area. Any movement outside that area will be accompanied by at least one other participant and with the expressed permission and knowledge of CGE's local director.
2. I will abstain from drinking any alcoholic beverage as a participant in the CGE Studies program, sponsored by CGE's local partner. I understand that this is a global guideline for CGE and their participating university members.
3. I will not produce, use, distribute, sell, or keep in my possession any illegal drugs.
4. I will not spend the night or reside in any location other than the approved housing to which I'm assigned, unless by the expressed permission of CGE's local director.
5. I will not leave the city of the CGE program, during the duration of the program or schedule any international trips for any reason without the expressed permission of CGE's local director.
6. I will be prompt and attend all classes and scheduled meetings as required.
7. I will carry out, to the best of my abilities, all academic assignments given to me.
8. I will abide by all directives and instructions given to me by authorized program staff and representatives of CGE.
9. I will not lie, cheat, or steal and will conduct myself with the utmost integrity and ethical behavior while participating in this program.
10. I will do my best to get along with other participants and maintain a spirit of open-mindedness to their opinions as well as spirit of forgiveness for perceived wrongs.
11. I will express any grievances about the summer program or participating personnel to the CGE's local Director within a reasonable time of the concerning issue.
11. I will respect local customs and not engage in any activities that bring disgrace or disrepute upon CGE or any of its program partners or representatives.
