REGULAR BOARD MEETING

Board President John Walker called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. in the East Carter County R-II Elementary Cafeteria. The following Board members were present: John Walker, Johnathan Collins, Jordan Collins, Stonie Croy and James Gore. Also present were Superintendent Dr. Richard Sullivan, High School Principal Jon McKinney, Middle School Principal Theresa Kearbey, Elementary Principal Kacie Kendrick, SpEd Director Danielle Sullivan, Board Secretary Kathey Dalton, staff members Kevin Asberry and Jordan Penn. Also present were Pauletta Walker, Doug Scott and Jan Scott.

SUPERINTENDENTS REPORT

Dr. Sullivan reported the electric bill was up again this month from this time last year. Dr. Sullivan said that our high school team have had a great run this season with softball winning 4<sup>th</sup> place in state, cross country had state winners and our cheerleaders will be going to state 4 time straight. He said that deer season had several deer harvested by our staff and students and the Veteran's Day assembly went well.
