





How has Covid-19 affected academics in our classrooms and students in Grundy County?

A typical school year has 180 instructional days

In addition to the virtual days, the students were also out for 11 snow/weather days. These days are built into the regular school calendar.

What does the data show that we need to spend ESSER money on to help the students of Grundy County?

We are required to give students a skills based screener three times a year to determine which of our students are most at risk for falling below grade-level. When given these screeners the 50th percentile is considered to be on grade-level. The table shows areas of concern for the county.
