

# EL ACCOMMODATIONS TRADITIONAL VS. VIP

Traditional	Who This Helps	Virtual
Modeling	Newcomers can follow modeling to understand content without complicated language	Videos uploaded to Schoology
Use of native language & translation apps	Newcomers who are literate in their native language or who use oral translation	Use of native language & translation apps ( <a href="#">Check out this video</a> )
Graphic organizers	All students – graphic organizers can be more advanced as students become more bilingual	Fillable PDFs, Student sends a picture of their written graphic organizer
Sentence Frames	Newcomers, students with intermediate language, and students who struggle with academic writing. Frames vary based on student level.	-Include sentence frame options in directions -Fillable PDFs/Word Doc Assignments
Alternate Assignments	Newcomers, students who struggle with reading	Use the <a href="#">individually assign feature</a> to give students an alternate way to show what they know
Paired Written and Oral Directions	Students who have better reading comprehension than listening comprehension, or vice versa. Newcomers who are learning letter-sound correspondence in English.	Include a video of you explaining the assignment instructions
Multiple Entry Points	All EL students who favor one language domain over another. Especially newcomers who need background knowledge.	Video, Audio, Pictures, Text, Discussion, Teams Meeting
Check for Understanding	All students, especially those who struggle with comprehension	Phone calls, Schoology Messaging
Read Aloud	Students who struggle with reading or who are just beginning to read in English	<a href="#">This video</a> shows three options, including the Read and Write Extension, naturalreader.com, and the built-in Schoology recorder
Extended Time	Students who are still “translating in their head,” students using another accommodation which takes extra time	Support with unfinished assignments, extended deadlines
Bilingual Dictionary	Newcomers who can read in their native language	Google Translate, <a href="#">online bilingual glossaries</a>
