Dear Parents/Guardians:

It is with deep regret that I am informing you that the Page Unified School District will be returning to remote learning effective Monday, November 16, 2020. The metrics for Coconino County are continuing to go up and the reports received from the County are indicating that Page is in the red for the second week in a row. We believe this is the best decision for the safety of our staff and students.

The district will remain in remote learning through the remainder of the first semester. During this time, we will continue to monitor the metrics and will provide communication to our families regarding second semester and what that will look like.

With respect to On-Site Support Services, the district will keep this open to families next week, but we will be going back to our original one location, which is the Page High School Gym. This change will also be effective on Monday, November 16, 2020. At the end of next week, we will be looking at the metrics once again and making a decision on whether we can keep this site open upon return from Thanksgiving break, or whether the district will need to apply for a waiver. Once again, we will notify families of the decision that is made.
