Policy S8: Education of Students with Disabilities
Adopted: September 17, 2020

Southwest Georgia STEM Charter School does not discriminate on the basis of disability. It is the policy of Southwest Georgia STEM Charter School to educate students with disabilities in accordance with federal and state laws, rule and regulation.
