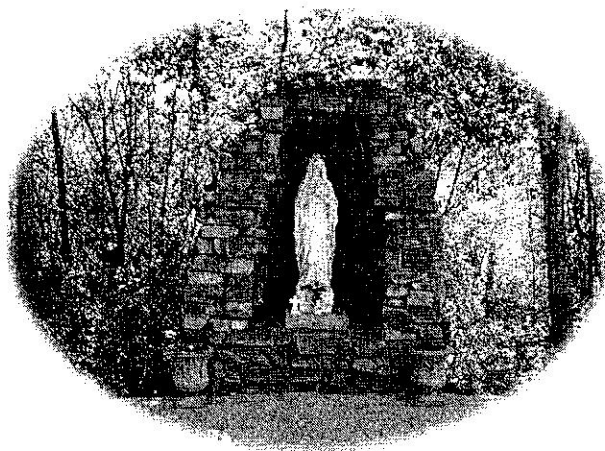

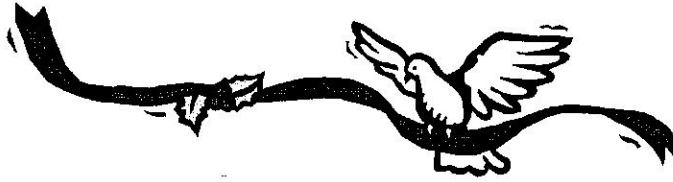
LOST AND FOUND: There are several articles in lost and found. Please call the Church Office for assistance.

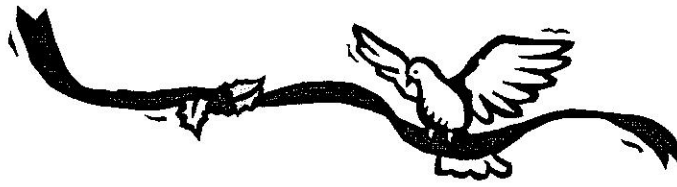
