Counselor's Corner - Mrs. Parker (School Advisor)-Welcome back! Staff and students are ready to jump back into our second semester! NEW THIS YEAR: According to the state, students need to be current on all immunizations and physicals this year to **remain in school**. Once an immunization certificate expires you have two weeks to comply with an updated immunization certificate. Students must have a physical upon entering the sixth grade-any student without a current physical has two weeks to comply. The district will not be accepting appointment cards as in the past. If you have questions regarding your child's current immunization or physical please call their doctor.
